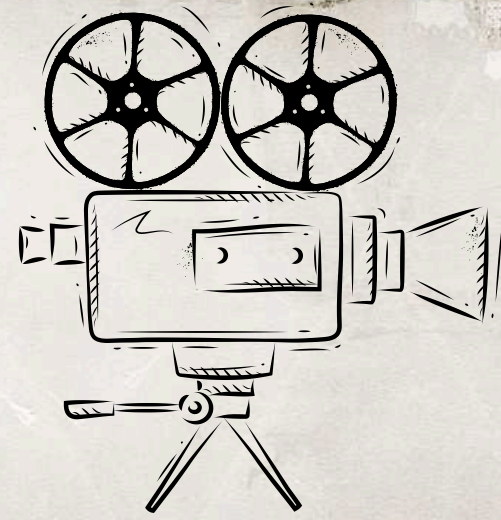

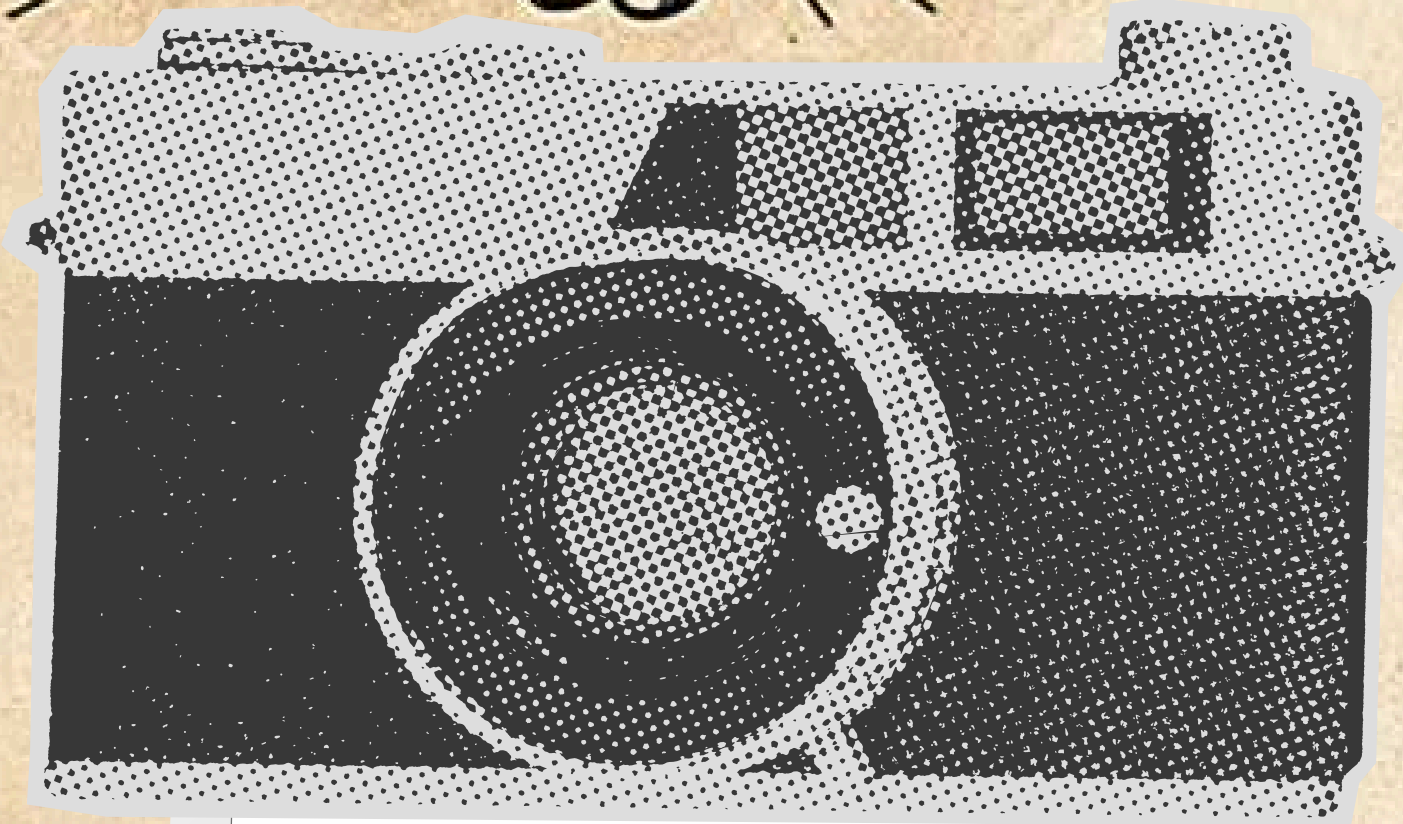

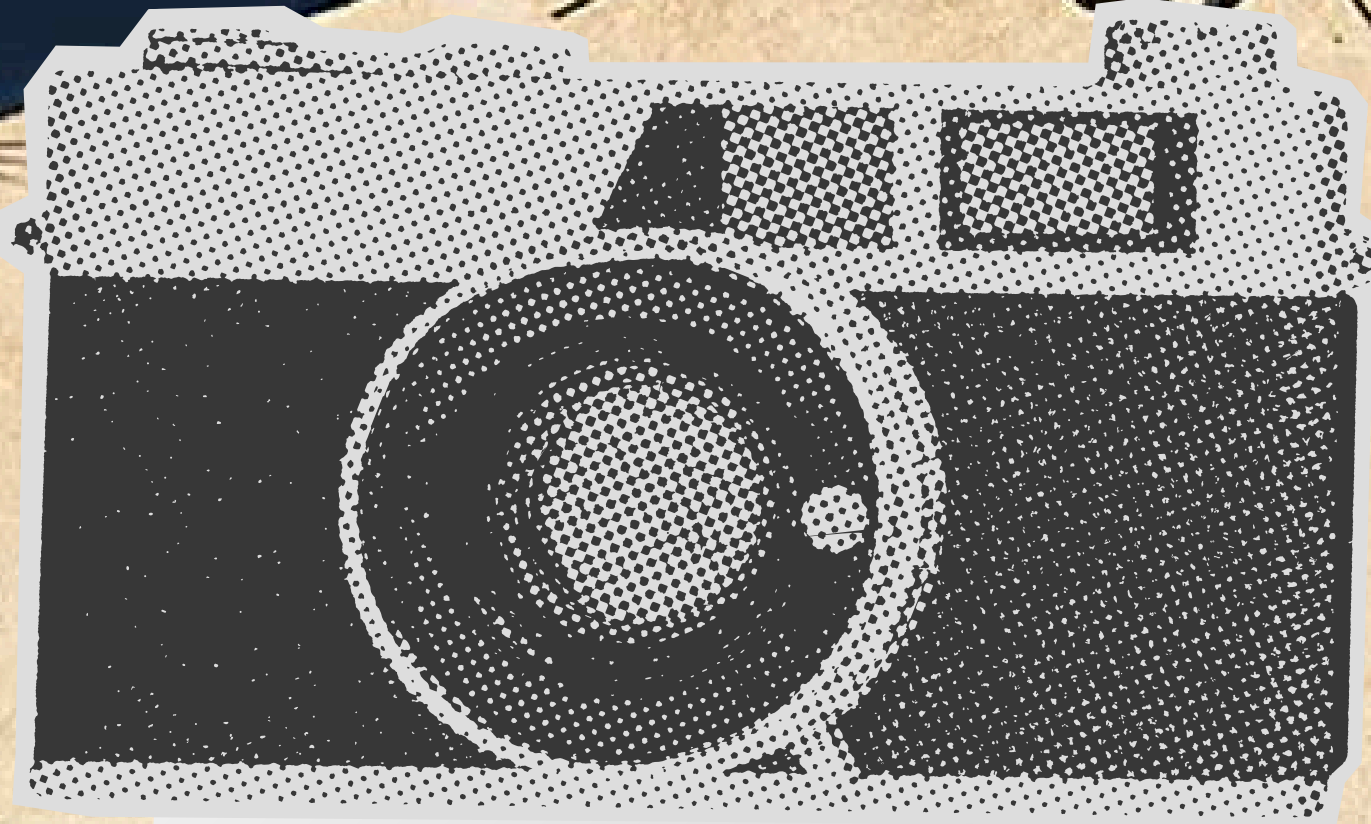
Sumit Nagal's rise as a tennis player and his journey from a small town in India to the international tennis circuit is truly an inspiration.

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

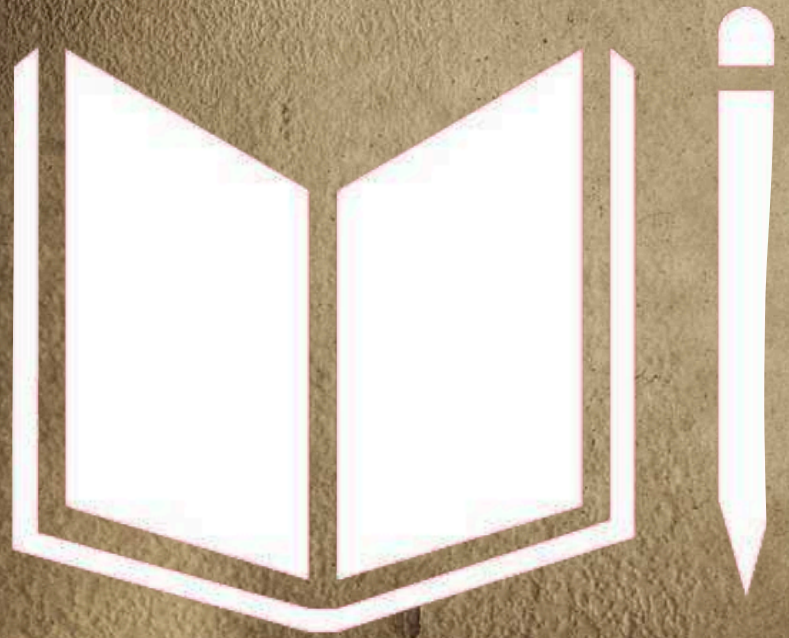
