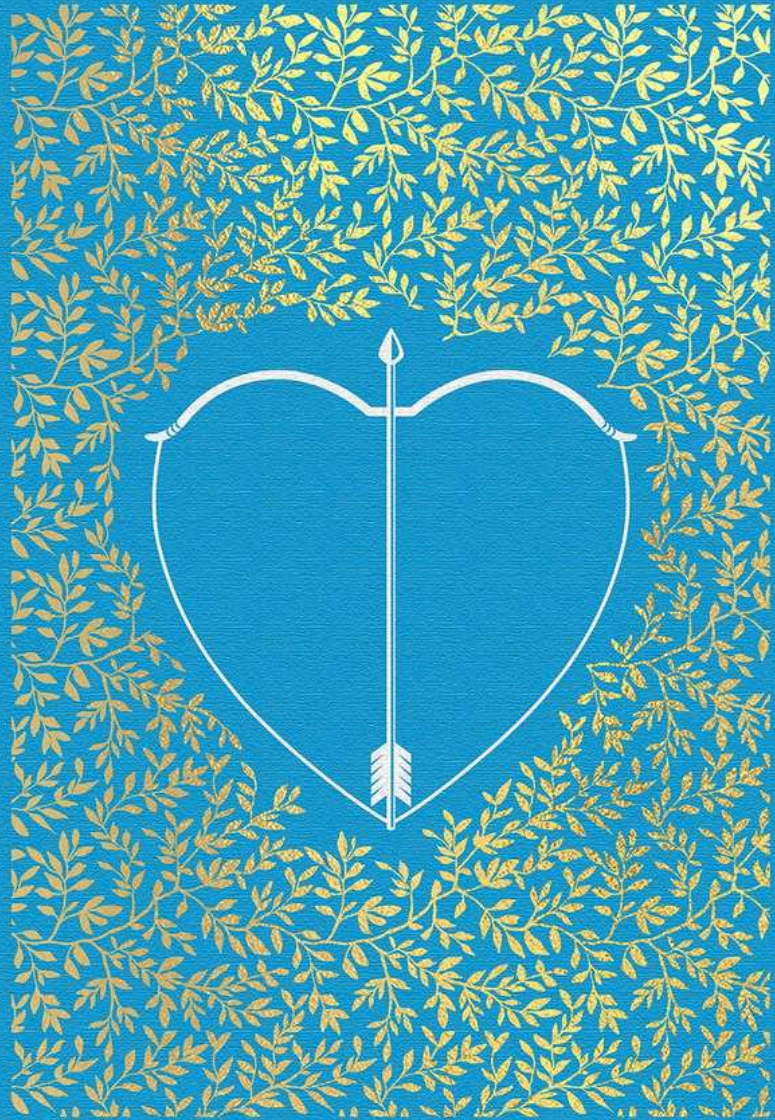

BOOK REVIEW

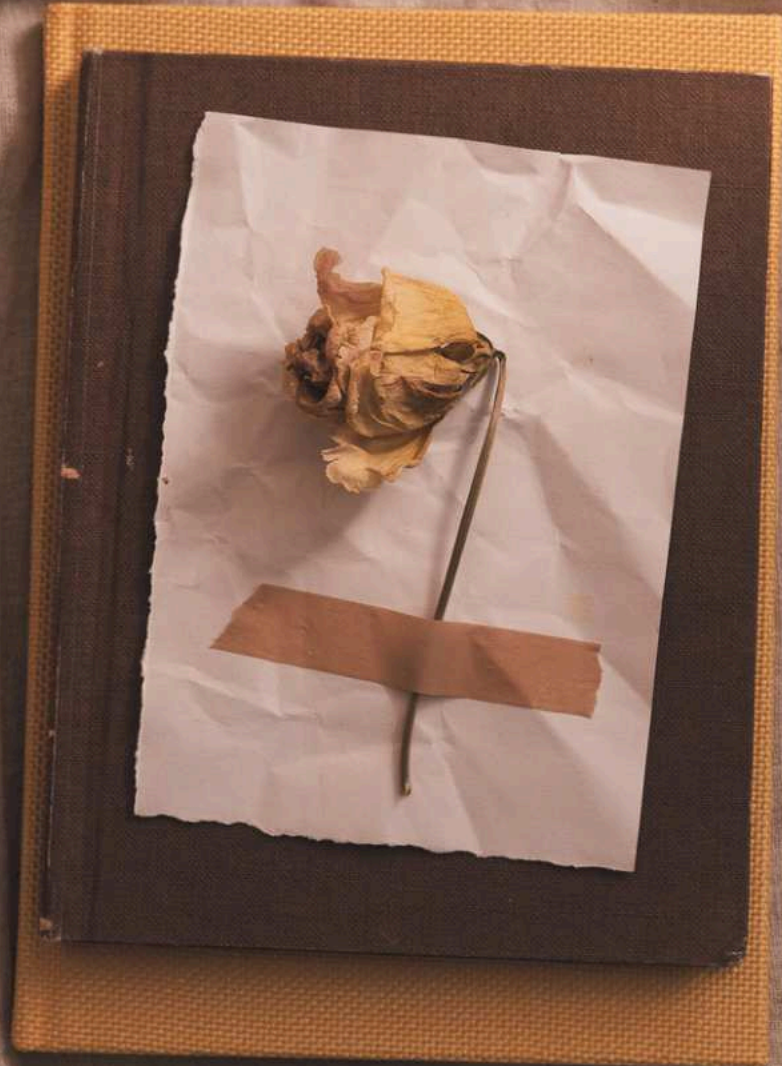
"The Song of Achilles" by Madeline Miller is an exquisite tapestry of emotions woven through the threads of Greek mythology. A book that has modernized the legendary work of Homer but stayed true to the core of the Iliad and resonates with haunting beauty that captures the essence of the ancient Greek world while breathing fresh life into the classic tale of Achilles and Patroclus. It encapsulates a story that is a timeless tragedy. It has an ending that is visceral yet so ethereal, gut-wrenching but still very enchanting. It may even be considered as a Modern Classic. I love the fact that the story is told from Patroclus' perspective, who is a very underrated character & hardly ever mentioned in Greek Mythology, however he is central to this tale. And through his eyes, we are all able to see all the facets of Achilles: the making of a hero still a boy at heart, shining and bright, easily seduced by glory, destined by fate on Trojan's side to become Aristos Achaion [the best of all Greeks]. Yet, his stubbornness & unyielding pride ultimately drives him to his downfall. This style of writing compels the reader to explore the vulnerabilities of heroism [Achilles], the fragility of life [Trojan War] and profound impact of love [Patroclus]. It isn't just a retelling, it's a timeless exploration of the human heart and forces that shape our lives. This novel explores themes of love, friendship, destiny and sacrifice against the backdrop of war and mythology.

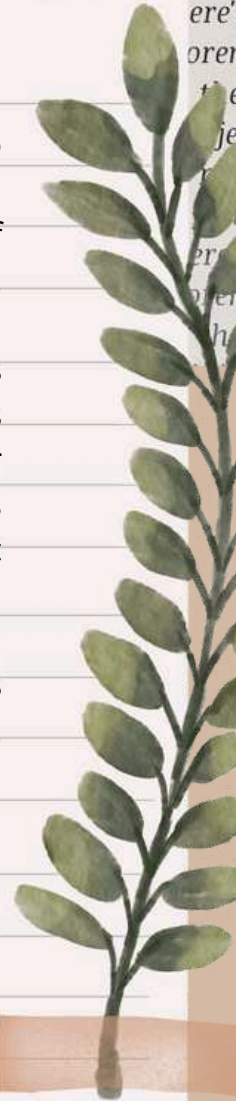

'Bloom'

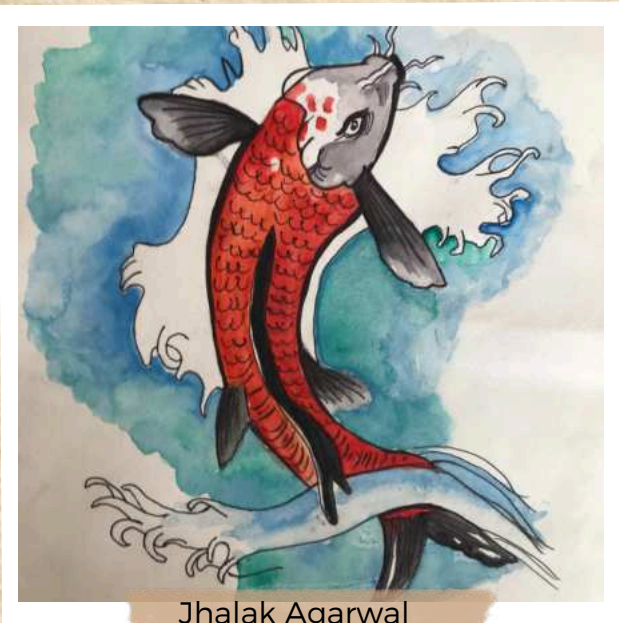
