

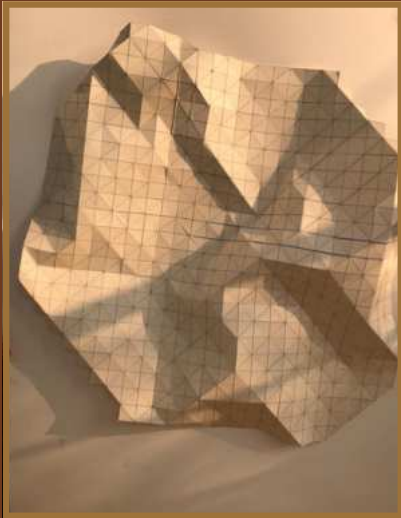

# 'OFF TUNE' - COLLAGE ON A GUITAR


