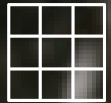


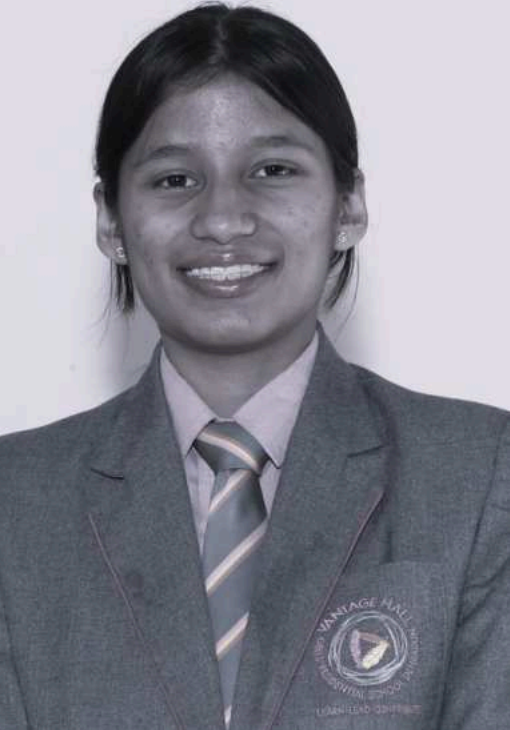

# WOMEN RESERVATION

After 27 years of legislative discussions, the parliament has eventually voted to enact the bill on reservation for women in Parliament. September 21, 2023 was a red letter day as all parties agreed to ensure at least one-third of women representation in the Lok Sabha and State Legislatures. After 11 hours of debate in the Upper House (Rajya Sabha) the bill was passed unanimously with 100% votes in favor. This is arguably, by far the most liberating step towards gender parity that India has seen.

It indeed is a welcome move towards women lead development, but I ask a question- "Would we not have been closer to achieving gender parity if this was done a decade back?" The answer is undoubtedly- "Yes!". Well now we can only hope that more time will not be lost in the implementation of this bill. Union Minister, Amit Shah, asserted that the Women's Reservation Bill will not be enforced till 2029. Interestingly, 2029 is also the year for the general election for Lok Sabha. I want to ask our politicians and the supporters of the patriarchy when will we see a proper representation of women in the seat of democracy? Or are women expected to wait as they have been waiting for decades?!

# G20: THE MET GALA OF DIPLOMACY

G20 or 'Global twenty' is a group of 19 countries and the European Union. It is a global platform where delegates or Ministers from different countries come together and discuss various global issues. The theme of India's G20 presidency "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or 'One Earth, One Family, One Future' is drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the 'Maha Upanishad', while the G20 logo draws inspiration from the vibrant colors of India's flag-saffron, white, green and blue. It depicts planet earth sitting atop a lotus which is India's national flower, the lotus reflects growth amid challenges, below the logo, the name "BHARAT" is written in Devanagari script.

On the first day our honorable President Draupadi Murmu and honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modi welcomed all the delegates and supreme leaders of different countries at the 'Bharat Mandapam' in New Delhi, which was chosen as the venue for G20 2023 in India. In the evening a special dinner was hosted for all the guests. The next two days were followed by the serious committee sessions where the main topic discussed were the three main resources affected by the Russia-Ukraine war, which are the three F's - 'Food, Fuels and Fertilizers'.

Lastly, PM Modi handed over the G20 presidential gavel to the Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula Da Silva and expressed faith that India's successor will further unite the world, after all, we are One Earth, One Family and we share One Future.

भारत द्वारा 14 जलाई ु 2023 को चंद्रयान-3 का सफल प्रक्षेपण किया गया। भारत की 'इंडियन स्पेस रिसर्च ऑर्गनाइजर्ग ेशन'(इसरो) द्वारा कई वर्षों की कड़ी मेहनत के बाद तीसरी बार चांद पर जानेकी कोशिश की गई और सफलता प्राप्त हुई। इस मिशन को चंद्रयान- 3 के नाम सेजाना गया है, इससेपहले भी 2019 मेंचंद्रयान-2 मिशन के तहत सटैलाइट को चांद पर भेजा गया था, लेकिन कुछ तकनीकी खराबी के कारण यह प्रक्षेपण सफल नहीं हो पाया था। चंद्रयान-3 चांद के दक्षिणी ध्रुव की सतह पर सॉफ्ट लैंडिंग करनेका भारत का दूसरा ू प्रयास था। भारत चंद्रमा के दक्षिणी ध्रुव पर उतरनेवाला विश्व का पहला देश है। चंद्रयान-3 की सफलता नेभारत को विश्व के अग्रणी देशों की श्रेणी मेंएक पायदान ऊपर पहुंचा दिया है। चंद्रयान - 3 के माध्यम सेभारत का लक्ष्य अपनेतकनीकी कौशल, वज्ञै ानिक क्षमताओंऔर अतं रिक्ष खोज के प्रति अपनेदृढ़ संकल्प को प्रदर्शितर्शि करना है। यह मिशन हमें विज्ञान,इंजीनियरिंग और गणित के क्षेत्र मेंअपनी क्षमताओंके अवसर हेतुमार्ग प्रशस्त करता है। भारत एक सशक्त राष्ट्र के रूप मेंविश्व पटल पर उभरता हुआ देश है, जिस पर परेविश्व की नज़रें आशावादी दृष्टिकोण के साथ टिकी हुई हैं, मझु ेअपनेभारतीय होनेपर गर्व है,मैंअपनी भारतीयता को अखंडित रखनेहेतुआजीवन वचनबद्ध हूं। भारत का यह प्रक्षेपण विकासशील भारत की अर्थर्थ यवस्था में मील का पत्थर साबित होगा और "जय जवान, जय किसान, जय विज्ञान" की उक्ति को चरितार्थ करेगा। धन्यवाद ।
